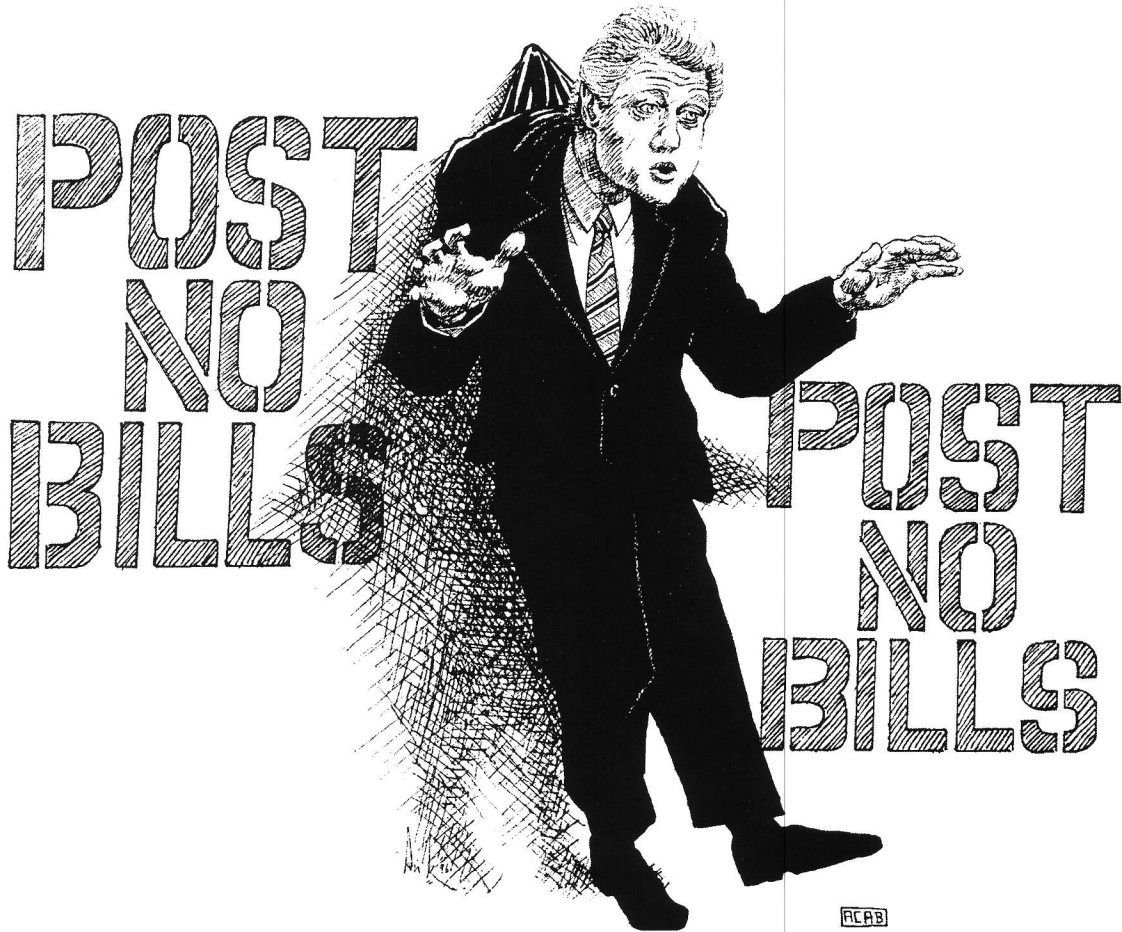
Prince: Musicology
