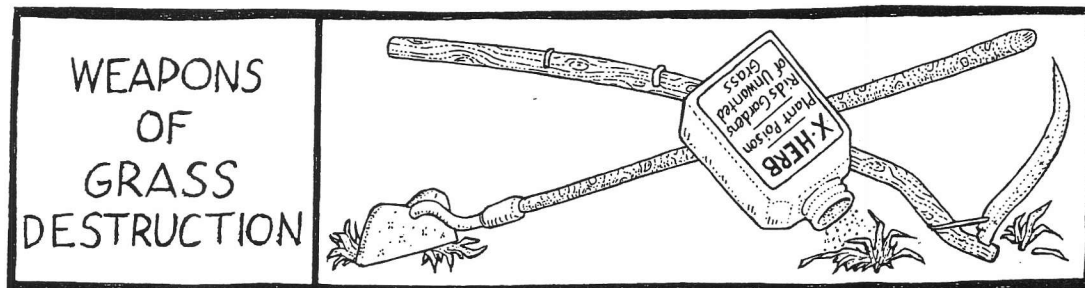
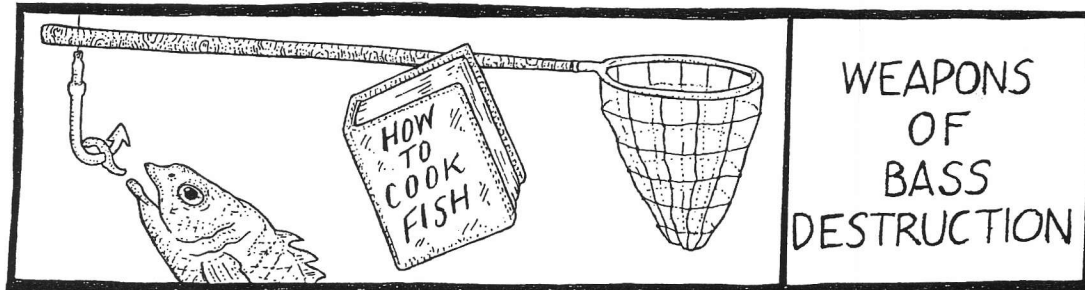
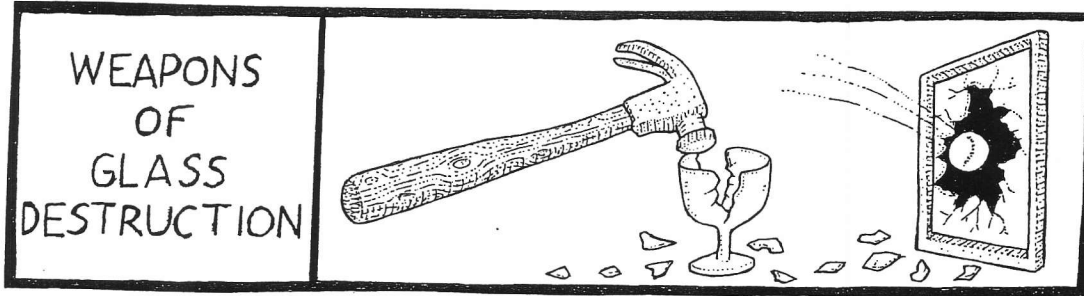

This latest release by piano maestro Eddie Palmieri is latin jazz at its best. Beginning with the tune "In Flight", which includes a smoking solo by violinist Regina Carter, it takes off and takes you on a ride of virtuoso playing by the whole ensemble. The percussion crackles & percolates, the horns sing & soar and Eddie is right there holding it down with his usual intensity on the keys.
